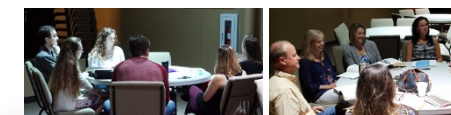
## SINGLES

9:45AM MARRIED AGES 30s-50s #250

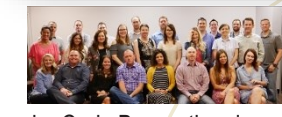


Voyagers is a unified group of team-players

## FISH

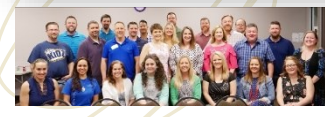
9:45AM MIXED AGES 40s-50s #255

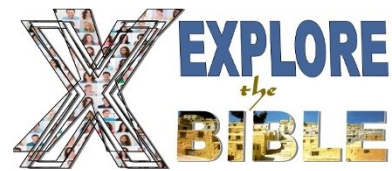

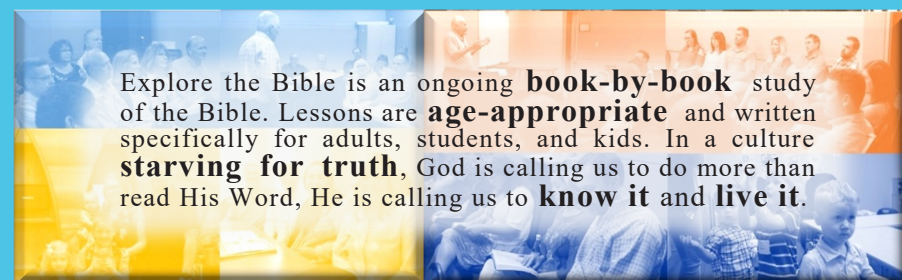
